

## 40<sup>th</sup> Annual Seedling Sale Selection

**Colorado Blue Spruce Seedlings & Transplants**– The variety offered will vary from blue to green. It is used for landscaping & Christmas trees. Transplants offer better survivability, with larger root systems and more branching. They are sold as three, 12-18” Transplants per package. The seedlings are available in several package sizes and are 10-18” tall.

**Norway Spruce** -Grows to 75 or 80 feet in height. Spread 35 to 40 feet. Dense, dark green needles never get longer than 1 inch. Thrives well in average soil conditions, but prefers moisture in the soil to maintain its deep green color. Highly valued ornamental and timber tree. One of the best conifers for shelters and windbreaks. Branches droop gracefully as tree matures, making this a very attractive ornamental. Offered as 12-18” Transplants

**American Arborvitae** - Also known as White Cedar. Grows to 40 feet. Spread 10 to 15 feet. Evergreen foliage is scale like and flat. Grows in ordinary soil, and also does well in swampy areas and alkaline soil. These trees are pyramidal in growth and well suited for windbreaks. Being sold as 18-24” transplants.

**Black Cherry** -Valuable timber tree which can be planted in open or as underplanting. Does well in wide variety of soil types. Good species for wildlife food. Grows to 60 feet. Fruit provides food for many small animals. They are 24-36” tall seedlings.

**River Birch** - A native birch to the river bottoms, but does well in many soils. Reddish brown exfoliating bark. They are being sold as 12-18” seedlings.

**Serviceberry** - Also known as Juneberry. Height 25 to 30 feet. One of the first native trees to bloom in early spring. Serviceberries are covered with billowy masses of small white flowers in racemes. The fruits are quite attractive to birds. Fall color is yellow to red. 24-36” seedlings are being offered.

**Hazelnut** - Also known as American Filbert. Medium fast growth rate. A multi-stemmed small tree, growing 10 to 15’ tall. Dark green summer foliage turns light yellow in fall. Edible nuts mature September to October. Sold as 18-24” seedlings.

**Lespedeza** – A new offering for our sale, this shrub, Bicolor Lespedeza is a perennial semi-woody legume. It can reach a height of 8 to 10 feet with 1/2 inch diameter stems, but cut back, stems will grow 4 to 6 feet tall. The small, black, bean-like, seeds are singly produced in pods which open when mature. Seeds are eaten by many wildlife species, It is being offered as 12-18” seedlings

**Concord Grape** – This is one of the most recognizable grape produced, it is used for jams, jellies and juice. A blue-black variety, having medium to large compact clusters. Vines are very winter hardy. We are offering 12-18” bareroot plants

**Blueberry** – Two different varieties are offered in this package, Bluejay and Bluecrop. Both are mid-season bearers. Blueberries prefer acidic, high organic soil with partial shade. The plants being offered are 18-30” tall.

**Apple Trees** – The two species being offered in this year’s package are Linda Mac and Galarina. LindaMac is a bright red, true McIntosh. It has the crisp sweet flavor and attractive appearance of a true Mac. Galarina fruit resembles Gala, small to medium in size, red to orange red, with some yellow background. Flavor is crisp and sweet and will store up to four months in regular cold storage. Galarina shows high tolerance to apple scab, mildew and fire blight.

**Tree Shelters** – These are 4-foot high tubes that offer newly planted seedlings protection from deer & rabbits. They work well with most deciduous (leafed) trees including; Cherry, Birch and Serviceberry being offered in this year’s sale. Shelters are not recommended for fruit trees due to their branching habit. The support stake is included with the price.

**Tree Mats** – These 3’ by 3’ mats are for protecting new seedlings from weed competition and moisture loss. The specially designed perforations allow moisture in but not out. They may be used with shelters and covered with mulch.

**Planting Bars** – These are steel bars with a flat plate at the bottom used primarily for planting seedlings.

**Bluebird Boxes** –These nesting boxes are for rearing the young birds. The boxes are made of rough-cut Hemlock
